'Home Town Boy' Returns to Preach Mission Festival.

The Rev. Christ Clausing, of West Bloomfield, Wisconsin, will be the guest speaker for morning services of the mission festival Sunday, sponsored by St. Peter Lutheran church. He is a home town product, a son of the late Henry Clausing. Born on the family farm homestead, located where the Arlington race track now stands, he was educated in the parish school of the church and made his confirmation vow in 1915. His preparatory education was received at Concordia College, Milwaukee and at the Lutheran Theological Seminary of St. Louis. He was ordained as a minister in 1925 and served at Scotts City, Kansas. Pastor Clausing is now in charge of a congregation at West Bloomfield, Wisconsin. Mrs. Clausing, nee Elda Drewes and two fine daughters, Naomi and Carol complete the happy family circle. The occasion of his appearance is the Mission Festival of the local Lutheran church. Equally proficient in German and English, the guest speaker will preach on a Mission topic in both morning services on Sunday, at 9:30 (German) and 11 a.m. (English). In the evening at 8 p.m. the congregation will enjoy the privilege of hearing a message from the new Stewardship Secretary.
