Services for Earl H. Crandall, 92, of 33 E. Maple, Roselle, were held Friday afternoon at the Martin Funeral Home, LTD., in Roselle. Burial was at Lake Street Memorial Park, Elgin. Mr. Crandall died last Wednesday, at St. Joseph Hospital, Elgin. The son of the late Julian and Esther Southworth Crandall, he was born Sept. 17, 1884 in Union, Ill.
