

Truman – Services for Marion Geistfeld, 90, of Truman will be 1:30 pm Wednesday, Nov. 24, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Truman. Burial will be in St. Paul's Lutheran Church Cemetery in Truman. Mrs. Geistfeld died Saturday evening, Nov. 20, 1993, at the Lutheran Retirement Home in Truman.
