

Mrs. Mina Kastning, 89, of Schaumburg, died this morning in the home of a daughter, Mrs. Alvina Moeller, of 619 Beverly Lane, Arlington Heights, where she had been for the past 11 weeks. She was born Dec. 10, 1869, in Huntley, the daughter of Henry and Wilhelmina Salge Thies. Two years later, the family moved to Schaumburg, here on June 4, 1891, she was married to John Kastning. They farmed in the vicinity, retiring in 1921. Mr. Kastning died in 1928.
