Neltnor, who served Wheaton as a police magistrate for fifty-two years, will be held at 2 pm today in his home at Washington street and Neltnor boulevard in the suburb. He died there Sunday of Pneumonia at the age of 97. Although inactive recently, Mr. Neltnor continued to be elected magistrate as an honor because of his long service. He also edited the DuPage county Democrat for fifteen years until his retirement twenty years ago. Mr. Neltnor was a former alderman, town clerk, and postmaster. His general store, which he operated until ten years ago, contained a safe which served as the first bank in Wheaton, when he moved there in 1855 from Bloomingdale. Surviving are five children, Kirk, Frank C., Carroll, Shelley, Mrs. Cornelia Antony, and Mrs. Louis Harris.
