Max Rickert was born January 8, 1877, in Wheaton, Ill., died at his home in Chicago, January 1, 1904, from diabetes. He lived in Chicago for two years and was employed in a gasoline lamp plant. He leaves a wife and one son eleven years of age. Mr. Rickert was for many years one of the substantial business men of Wheaton. He was a charter member of Wheaton M.W.A. Camp, No.488. The remains were brought to Wheaton for interment Wednesday, the services at home being under management of the Woodmen, assisted by Dr. Carr. About sixty Woodmen were in attendance to pay their last respects to the departed neighbor.
