

Edmond A. Rohlwing

Edmond A. Rohlwing, 82, of Genoa, passed away Thursday, January 13, 2000 at the Florence Nursing Home in Marengo. He was born June 16, 1917 in Elk Grove Township, the son of Herman and Emma (Panzer) Rohlwing. He married Lorraine M. Nebel Bartels on February 28, 1943 in Schaumburg. They farmed in Schaumburg until 1959 when they moved to Hampshire Township. Edmond was a very active former member of St. Peters Lutheran Church of Schaumburg serving as a church elder, church trustee and vice-president, and as a member of the Board of Christian Education. For the past 28 years, he had lived in Genoa and was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church of Genoa. Surviving are two daughters, Dolores (Warren) Schuring of Plato Township and Shirley (John) Kriegel of Hampshire; two sons, Leslie (Darlene Rohlwing and Stanley (Kathy) Rohlwing, both of Marengo; a daughter-in-law, Kathleen Rohlwing of Lake Mills, Wis.; 16 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Loraine on February 19, 1993; a son, Ron on June 30, 1994; and three brothers, Erwin, Harvey and Raymond Rohlwing. Funeral services will be held at 1 pm Monday, January 17 at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Genoa with the Rev. Harold Schmidt officiating. Burial will be in the Hampshire Center Cemetery.
