Christ Schmale Dies, Farmer Here Many Years

Christ Schmale, 77 years old, who has been a farmer near Wheaton most of his life, died yesterday at his home, the second farm north of the Great Western tracks at Gretna. Born in Mickellinburg, Germany, Oct 5, 1863, he came to this country at the age of 4 with his parents.
