

Emil F. Schrage – Schaumburg

Emil F. Shrage, 78, pioneer resident of Schaumburg, died Wednesday in Sherman Hospital where he was admitted a day earlier. He was born in Schaumburg Twp. Oct. 1884, the son of Fred and Sophia Heide Schrage. He was married to Laura Geistfeld in Schaumburg, where they farmed until 1923. After that, he was employed by the State Highway Department until he retired in 1962. He was a member of St. Peters Lutheran Church of Schaumburg, where he served as church janitor for 23 years, a cemetery trustee and a past church elder. Surviving besides the widow is one daughter, Mrs. Daniel (Lauraette) Frost of Roselle., five grandchildren, three brothers, Herman, Louis and Martin, all of Schaumburg twp., and one sister, Mrs. Martha Hardke of Chicago. He was preceded in death by a son, Edwin, and two sisters in infancy. Funeral services will be Saturday at 2 from St. Peters Lutheran Church, Schaumburg, the Rev. John Sternberg officiating.
