Doris Siems, 64, of Clarksville, died Wednesday, Sept 18, 1996 at North Iowa Mercy Health Center. Funeral services were held Saturday, Sept. 21, at Immanuel United Church of Christ in Clarksville, with the Rev. David Walters officiating. The casketbearers were Tracy Slocum, Darwin Johnson, Duane Johnson, Chuck Franken, Bob Franken, Roger Mobley, and Jeramy Siems as honorary casket bearer. Burial was in Lynwoon Cemetery in Clarksville. Schwartz Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements. She was born July 6, 1932, in Franklin County near Ackley, the daughter of Fred and Elizabeth Fisher Wildeboer. She was baptized into the Christian faith in 1936, by S.M. Becker, the Lutheran pastor in Clarksville and was confirmed at Dumont Reformed Church on June 19, 1948. She graduated from Dumont High School in 1951. On Feb. 2, 1952, she married Raymond Siems at the Washington Reformed Churches parsonage in Ackley. After their marriage, they lived in Hampton, Ackley, Charles City, and finally in Clarksville in 1955. She had been employed previously at Maytag Corp. in Hampton, Skitec Corp. in Waverly and Salsbury Corp. in Charles City as a lab technician. She was a member of Immanuel United Church of Christ, which she joined in March 30, 1958. She enjoyed sewing, crocheting, golfing, baking and cherished spending time with her family. She is survived by her husband; two sons, Randy of Parkersburg, and Bradley of Waverly; two daughters, Terri Siems of Clarksville and Mrs. Dave (Sandra) Smith of Rudd; six grandchildren; and three great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, two brothers, two sisters and one twin sister.
