SCHOOL CHOIR LEADER DEAD

A.W. Stellhorn, Teacher at Lutheran Institution Here, Was Widely Known A.W. Stellhorn, 49, widely known choir leader, died late Friday at his home, 3427 N. 45th st., of pneumonia . He was a teacher at the Immanuel Lutheran Day School, connected with the church at Teutonia and Meinecke avs., for 13 years. For 10 years he was in charge of the choir there. The school choir, one of the state's outstanding children's groups, has been heard several times over WTMJ and received wide acclaim after appearances at the Chicago world fair. Mr. Stellhorn was a native of Redbud, Ill. Surviving him are his wife, Frieda; four daughters, Mildred, Dorothy, Selda and Ruth; 6 sisters and six brothers, none of whom live here.
