- Temperature/Ventilation

Electrical Precautions

- Surge Protectors
 - Prevent electrical shock to power supply, MBoard, network card, and other components
 - Avoids repeated shut down/start up issues that can occur during brown outs/flickering power
 - Depending on model can allow for a controlled shutdown in the event of a power failure
- When to Shut Down
 - o Severe weather
