Instructions for Using hoopla:

1. Visit www.hoopladigital.com OR **Download the hoopla app** from Apple's App Store, Android's Google Play store, or Amazon's App Store.
 2. Click the Get Started button. Sign up for an account by entering your email address and a password.
 3. Choose Library - Bloomingdale Public Library (IL).
 4. Enter your Library Card Number and Library PIN.
 5. Once your account is created and you're logged in, browse and search for titles.
 6. Once you've found a title, click on the title's cover.
 7. Click the Borrow button.
 8. Click the Read button or the Play button.
- On mobile devices, you can stream content (click the Read or Play button) or download it to your device. If you're planning on reading or watching on the go, it's recommended to download the title to your device.
9. Find borrowed titles under the drop-down menu My Hoopla - Currently Borrowed.
