Volunteer Restoration & Native Plant Nursery Workday Schedule

NOM Natural Resource Management

JULY – SEPTEMBER 2022



Volunteer workdays give forest preserve fans a way to help restore biodiversity and function to our native ecosystems. Each <u>restoration</u> workday is planned by a site steward (who are also dedicated volunteers themselves) and includes orientation, a safety talk and a hands-on natural-areas-management project. From late fall to early spring, they work to remove invasive species usually using cutting tools (loppers and bow saws) or disperse native seed to increase diversity in degraded areas or where invasive plants have been removed. In spring, summer and fall, volunteers also do invasive species removal and hand collect seed from native plants when they are ready. At the <u>native plant nursery</u>, volunteers assist staff with various tasks like weeding, watering, collecting seeds, planting plugs and maintaining walkways. As a volunteer, you'll not only give the forest preserves a much needed helping hand but also learn about native plants and how to use them in your own backyard. Nursery workdays run from late April – November.

Registration

Registration is important. When site stewards and staff know in advance how many volunteers to expect, they can bring the right amount of supplies and equipment to ensure safe, productive workdays. Registrants will also receive a map specifying where to park within the preserve. Please make sure to review all requirements before attending.

Individuals must register at least five business days before a workday either online at https://apm.activecommunities.com/fpddc/Home by searching for the activity number listed next to the workday, by emailing nrvolunteer@dupageforest.org, or calling (630) 206-9630. You'll need to provide your name, phone number, and an email address. For any dates listed under "Partner Organization Workdays," please follow the instructions listed. Individuals cannot apply workdays toward court-ordered community service. For these types of service projects, call the Forest Preserve District's Human Resources department at (630) 933-7682.





Young volunteers and organized groups of five or more — such as, students fulfilling service-learning or class requirements, and religious, corporate or Scout groups — must register 10 business days before the workday at (630) 206-9630, or by emailing nrvolunteer@dupageforest.org. You'll need to provide your name/name of the group, phone number, email address and the number of participants.

Restoration workdays are appropriate for individuals 8 and older. For children ages 8 to 10, there must be one adult for every two children; for children ages 11 to 18, there must be one adult for every eight. Nursery workdays are for individuals 12 and older. A parent will need to stay at the workday if their child is under 18, but high school students have the option to bring a friend to fulfill this requirement.

Waiver Requirements

All volunteers who are not badged District volunteers must submit a signed waiver form to the site steward at the beginning of the workday. Volunteers under 18 must have their parents or guardians sign their waivers.

How to Prepare

Dress in layers, and wear sturdy shoes or boots, long pants, and long-sleeved shirts. Because you'll work in thorny, brushy areas and occasionally among poisonous plants, do not wear shorts or thin leggings. Flip-flops, sandals and open-toe shoes are not allowed. If possible, bring your own work gloves. Water, sunscreen, and bug spray is also recommended. Most of the work areas are off trail on uneven terrain.

Cancellations

Cancellations occasionally occur due to weather, especially when a forecast calls for extreme high or low temperatures, sub-zero wind chills, or when there's lightning or heavy rain. Do not go to a workday if there is a strong chance of severe weather. A workday will likely take place if there's only a slight drizzle, but for the safety of our employees and volunteers, we will cut it short if there's lightening or thunder. For this reason, participants will need their ride on site in case severe weather moves in before the workday is scheduled to end. COVID-19 Precautions

In accordance with the CDC's updated masking recommendations and a mandate by the Illinois governor, the Forest Preserve District updated its mask guidance as follows:

District employees, volunteers, contractors, and visitors will no longer be required to wear masks indoors at District facilities.

- Any employee or visitor who prefers wearing a mask for any reason, regardless of vaccination status, is encouraged to continue to do so.
- For projects with canvas gloves a pair can be issued to borrow for the event. If possible, we suggest that volunteers bring their own work gloves to the workday.
- Volunteers should bring their own water or snack if needed. For hot days please bring extra water. We will not be able to
 provide snacks or drinks.
- Volunteers should bring their own sunscreen and/or bug spray if needed.
- MOST IMPORTANTLY, if any volunteer is sick, is home with someone who is sick, or is showing any symptoms of COVID-19, <u>PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE WORKDAY</u>.

If ANY District volunteer is sick or is home with someone who is sick:

- The volunteer must notify his/her supervisor of the illness or exposure to illness.
- The volunteer must immediately send an email to HR representatives, Christina Watson and Megan Denniger, to notify them of the illness / exposure to illness.
- If a volunteer reasonably connected with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please notify HR immediately.
- BEFORE the volunteer returns to the District, a conversation between the volunteer, HR and Volunteer Services must take
 place to confirm the steps that will be required to authorize a return to the District. The volunteer may not return without
 approval from HR.
